Death sentence passed on Anthony Patiniatt.

The Cabinet, having considered and given due weight to the written report of the case of Anthony Patiniatt made by the Chief Justice and the other trial Judges to H.E. the Governor in terms of section 116(2) of the Constitution, in which they communicated to him the jurors' recommendation for mercy and made observations thereon, as well as the written advice of the Attorney-General in terms of the same provision of the Constitution and the relevant records, agreed to advise H.E. the Governor to commute the sentence of death passed on the said Anthony Patiniatt by Her

Majesty's Criminal Court on the 1st October, 1963, to one of hard labour for life.
