Sec. 205/59/1 visit to Malta of U.S. Sixth Fleet between
November 13-22, 1965 (Memo. No. 516)

Hon. Ministers having
 perused Memorandum No. 516 agreed that
 the current restrictions on the berthing in
 Malta harbours of gasoline ships accompanying
 naval forces be removed. In anticipation
 of the amendment of the current regulations
 it was decided that gasoline ships accompanying
 the Sixth Fleet during their visits to Malta
 should be allowed to berth in Vassallo Harbour.

It was agreed that the composition of the Hospital Management Committee in respect of St. Luke's Hospital be changed and that section 29 of the Medical & Health Department (Constitution (Amendment) Emergency Ordinance, 1959, be amended accordingly. Before the amendment to the Ordinance was drafted, the Hon. Sec. of Health was to discuss the proposed constitution of the Committee with the Hon. Minister.

Hon. Ministers, having perused Memorandum No. 506 and heard the views of Mr. Bugeja, Mr. Muscat and Mr. Podesta, agreed that the refund of 66 $\frac{2}{3}$ % of the surcharge imposed by the British Government on certain imports into the United Kingdom be continued for another year as from the 26th October 1965.
