Disposal of Redundant Staff at the C.R.S.
(Memo. No. 584.)

(Mr. S. Meggi was in attendance)

Hon. Ministers considered
the question of the redundant staff - now
numbering 250 - at the C.R.S. vis-a-vis
their already declared intention not to
effect discharges. After a full discussion
on the possible redeployment of this staff,
it was agreed that the question be

presented immediately by the Secretary, Ministry of Finance, Customs & Ports, together with the Heads of the departments of Works, Agriculture, Health, Education and Labour. Hon. Ministers were to be informed of the results of the study at the next meeting of the Cabinet on Tuesday, 10th May, 1966.

Hon. Ministers approved the above two Bills and agreed that they be presented to Parliament.

Hon. Ministers were informed that the Staff Side had called on the Acting Prime Minister to ask for the release of the schedule of anomalies that existed in the Civil Service salary structure, and which Government intended to adjust. During the interview the Acting Prime Minister maintained that the Prime Minister's promise would be honoured because the required details were going to be released to the Staff Side concurrently with their presentation

to Parliament within a few days.
