Ministers agreed that Malta should become a party to the Customs Convention concerning Welfare Material for Seafarers, subject to the condition that temporary free importation into Malta of welfare material for the purpose of Article 5 of the Convention should be allowed against a deposit covering the import duty chargeable on the imported material, which import duty would be refunded on the re-exportation of such material.
