DUAL CITIZENSHIP

A number of enquiries have been made at the Immigration and Nationality Branch of the Office of the Prime Minister regarding the position under the provisions of the Constitution and the Maltese Citizenship Act of persons holding dual citizenship.

In this connection, the Government will be introducing before Parliament a Bill which would make it possible for persons who did not renounce the citizenship of a Country other than Malta within the period specified by law to retain their Maltese citizenship.
