Cabinet Meeting held at the Amburge d'Argon, Valletta, on Tuesday, 4th October, 1966, at 11 a.m.

Admiralty Floating Dock No. 35 (Memo. No. 5443)

Hon. Ministers were informed
of correspondence at Refs 122 to 125 in
file. In view of this correspondence and
of the official confirmation that the Floating
Dock was in full operation at Hammoor.

Japan (Ref 126 in file) they agreed that the existing Banker's Guarantee be waived.

Uniforms of the Executive Staff of the Courts (Demo. No. 624).

(Mr. E. Gachini, Administrative Secretary, was in attendance)

The Cabinet was informed that the Executive Staff of the Courts had agreed to suspend the industrial action in order that negotiations on their proposals for a change of uniforms could be started. In view of this information it was agreed that consideration could now be given to the proposals contained in the memorandum. It was felt that a light material in blue, similar to that worn by the Messengers in the House of Representatives, would be suitable for the Executive Staff of the Courts.

Construction of Concrete Caissons at Pietà Creek (Demo. No. 663)

The Cabinet considered memorandum No. 663 and agreed that the Company should not be permitted to carry out its proposal to construct concrete caissons at Pietà Creek or at any other locality in Marsamxett Harbour. Everything possible was to be done to keep that Harbour free for the

Yachting Centre activities. It was suggested that a suitable place for the project would be at St. Abigail in Sgo.
