Remission of British Defence Forces in Malta.

(Dr. M. Taffin and Mr. F. Amato Jani were in attendance.)

The Cabinet was informed of the latest developments in the dispute over the proposed remission of British Defence Forces in Malta. It was agreed that the release of goods intended for the Services and for individual members of the Services or their families, and which were exempt from ~~the~~ import duties, be withheld pending a further Cabinet

decision.

Visiting Forces (Amendment) Bill.

It was agreed that the second reading of the Bill be moved when the House of Representatives meets on Wednesday, 10th February, 1967.
