Reference was made to the
decision taken in Cabinet on the 14th March,
1964, on the question of the rent for Government-
owned sites required for the erection of
hotels. The Cabinet reconsidered the

matter and decided that the rent for such sites should ^{continue to} be assessed as Levetojone in respect of all applications which had already been received and were being considered by the Government. Similar applications would in future be dealt with in accordance with a new policy to be agreed upon in Cabinet at a later date.
