Joint Mission for Malta Report.

The Cabinet considered and agreed to the recommendations contained in Chapters 1, 2 and 3 of the Joint Mission for Malta Report. The following remarks were made:

Chapter 2.

A. Electricity. The financing of, and.

other matters connected with Stage II project are to wait until the Malta Electricity Board submits its report on the tenders received for the extension of the power station.

B. Water. all possible action is to be taken by the Department concerned to bring down waste to 12% of production by 1972.

A revision of the tariff structure is to be made for all water consumption, other than that used for domestic purposes.

C. Roads. The Cabinet is to expedite consideration of plans for the North Western Region and other parts of the Island, as soon as they are completed by the Public Works Department.

D. Ports. The establishment of a Port Authority and the building of quays, storage space and passenger terminal facilities are to be studied further.

E. Airport. The future extension

F. Telephones. of the existing runway and the expansion of the airport buildings, as well as improvements of the present telephone services, are to be studied and reported upon by special consultants from abroad, preferably from the Continent.
