OPM. 551/65/III Salary Adjustments (Improved Officers) (Memo. No. 869)

Reference was made to the decision taken in Cabinet on the 14th October, 1964 (Sitting No. 94/64) regarding the increase in the incremental rate. The matter was considered again and it was ^{now} agreed that all incremental rates of £ 15 and under should be increased

by L.S. and that all biennial increments should be converted into annual increments.
