CPM. 913/64. Draft Factories (Extension of Definition)
Order, 1968.

Further consideration of
 the proposal to make the above Order
 was left to another meeting of the Cabinet.
 Meanwhile copy of the draft Order was

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to be sent to the Hon. Minister of Health for his views.

OPM. 906/66 Transfer of documents from the Ambasciata d'Onore, Valletta, to the Royal Malta Library.

The Cabinet agreed to the proposal (mins. 45 + 46 in file) that files and other documents over 100 years old which were of historical importance should be preserved at the Royal Malta Library.

OPM. 312/68. Requests by Messrs. Carreras of Malta Ltd. for a factory site (Memo. No. 1002).

The Cabinet considered Memorandum No. 1002 and agreed that the Company should be offered a site already owned by the Government.

OPM. 1686/69 Memorandum By-Pass Project (Memo. No. 913).

The Cabinet agreed to the recommendation made in the Memorandum that provision should be made for the construction of suitable premises for alternative accommodation for the business premises which were being demolished as a result of the implementation of the Memorandum By-Pass Project.

OPM. 126/68 Extension to the Catholic Institute, Gloriosa

(Memo. No. 953)

The Cabinet agreed that the request of the Director of the Catholic Institute, Gozania, for a plot of land on the premises between the Catholic Institute and Hartgany House, Gozania, should not be acceded to.
