in the draft Bill attached to Memorandum No. 10/5.

OPM. 424/48/II. Price of Petrol and of Sea Oil.

The Cabinet considered again the question of the price of petrol and of gas oil in view of the pressure which was being made by the Companies for a revision of the price. It was agreed that the time was not opportune for a favourable consideration of the claims for an increase in the price of petrol and of gas oil.

Land 608/62. H.C. The Governor General was advised to sign the enclosed Declaration for the acquisition of a rural room at Lina Road, Rabat, Malta, required by the Government in connection with road widening.

Land 1052/66. H.C. The Governor General was advised to sign the enclosed Declaration for the acquisition of land at Rabat, Malta, required for the preservation of historical remains.
