OPM. 744/68.

Lease of land at district to Mr. Luke V. Sanci.
for the production of snussh (Memo. No. 1085)

In connection with Memorandum
 No. 1085 Ministers asked that particulars of
 the required plot of land and parts of the
 foreshore and of the adjoining seabed at district
 be produced.

OPM. 932/64/5

Compensation for damages sustained by Private
Property in Sgo in 1964 (Memo. No. 1005).

Ministers considered Memorandum No. 1005. They agreed that all available funds should be distributed on a percentage basis. They agreed also that Governments should contribute possibly beyond the existing sum of £1067 up to an amount of £3755.

CPM. 182/68. Eradication of Caprine Brucellosis (Mem. No. 970)
Ministers considered Memorandum No. 970 and agreed that the existing procedure (payments of bonus) for the eradication of caprine brucellosis should be changed to one of compulsory testing with slaughter of positive goats and payments of £10 compensation per head for goats slaughtered.

CPM. 1348/62. Housing development at Inverch and taking over of Old Railway Station at Hemmunn by the Milk Marketing Undertaking (Mem. No. 1098)
Ministers considered Memorandum No. 1098. They agreed that the Milk Marketing Undertaking should make use of the Old Railway Station at Hemmunn till the time when the site was required by the Ministry of Education, Culture & Tourism for the building of a school.

It was known that the Milk Marketing Undertaking had already vacated the stores on the site opposite the Church at Inverch. The Hon. Minister of

Public Building & Works was therefore asked to make an immediate start on the housing development of the area.

Confirmation of Written Opinion.

The files mentioned hereunder were circulated to Ministers whose written opinion was as follows:

Land 824/64. H.E. the Governor General was advised to sign Declaration for the acquisition of a plot of land at Coimbi required by the Government in connection with road widening.

Land 286/68. H.E. the Governor General was advised to sign Declaration for the acquisition of premises Nos. 146/148, Main Street, with another entrance at No. 3, Alley 9, Main Street, Suda, required by the Government in connection with the opening of a new street.

Land 891/65. H.E. the Governor General was advised to sign Declaration for the acquisition of land and of premises Nos. 112, 113 and 114 Kassarlokki Quay at Kassarlokki required in connection with the construction of fishermen's dwellings.
