by employees in the Milk Marketing Undertaking.

Recommendations made by the Malta Branch

Ministers considered Res. 3
in July in the light of what was stated by
"Finance" in Res. 5. They agreed as follows:

a) That the period between a
dissolution and the publication of the result
of the next ~~ensuing~~ ensuing general election
happening before 1964 should be reckoned
for pension purposes in relation to a
member who is re-elected.

b) That members of Parliament who
reside in Sgo should be paid £1 for
every sitting of the House they attend, in
lieu of the current fixed allowance of
£50 a year.
