Construction of a factory by the Malta Margarine Co. Ltd. (Memo. No. 1081)

(The Commissioner of Lands was in attendance)

Ministers agreed to the proposals contained in Memorandum No. 1081 for the building of a factory for the production of margarine, lard and ghee at Hjerik Road, Bays, by the Malta Margarine Co. Ltd.

Apprehension by Messrs. Denette Ltd. for emphyteutical grant of Selman Palace (Memo. No. 1064).

Ministers considered Memorandum No. 1064. They agreed that Selman Palace and adjoining grounds be granted to Messrs. Denette Ltd. on long lease to run with effect from the date of the expiry of the current emphyteusis held by Messrs. Residentials Ltd., provided

a) Messrs. Denette Ltd. would still be the lessees of the property when the current emphyteusis expired;

b) the new emphyteutical grant be for a period of thirty (30) years from 21st April, 1973;

c) the ground rent be at a commercial rate.
