Cabinet Meeting held at the Auberge d'Argon, Valletta, on Thursday, 26th September, 1968, at 11 am.

The Minutes of Meeting No. 71/68 were read and confirmed.

OPM. 1234/68. Health Insurance Scheme (Memo. No. 864)

Ministers referred to their decision taken in Cabinet on the 26th September, 1967, and enquired about the outcome of the visit to Malta of the two Experts in Health Insurance, and whether they had submitted their report.

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Ministers agreed in principle to the establishment of a duty free shop at Luga Airport. The Hon. Prime Minister undertook to see representatives of the General ^{Retailers} ~~Stores~~ Union on the matter.

OPT. 444/68.

Mandatory Standards for articles, imported and produced locally (Memo. No. 1053)

Ministers agreed to the recommendations contained in memorandum No. 1053 for the enactment of enabling legislation for the establishment of mandatory standards for imported articles and for those produced locally.

OPT. 388/68.

Cement Projects (Memo. No. 1106)

Ministers considered memorandum No. 1106 and agreed that the two applications for the setting up of cement projects, filed with the Malta Development Corporation, should for the moment be held up.

OPT. 1034/68.

Replacement of wall at San Anton Gardens (Memo. No. 1126)

Ministers considered memorandum No. 1126. They agreed that the existing stone facade of San Anton Gardens should not be demolished and replaced by a rustic wall, as recommended in the memorandum.
