OPM. 1334/67 Health Insurance Scheme. (Memo. No. 864)

Ministers were informed
that the two Experts in Health Insurance
had submitted a preliminary report to the
Hon. Minister of Labour, Employment & Welfare
before they left Malta. A final report
approved by the I.L.O. and W.H.O. had not

yet been received. The Hon. Minister of Labour, Employment and Welfare stated that he was preparing a memorandum on the matter for consideration by Cabinet.

Emphtutical grants of Government sites for the construction of Hotels and Tourist Projects (Memo. No. 961).

Reference was made to the decisions taken in Cabinet on the 20th August and 24th September, 1968. It was now agreed that the Standing Committee should include also the United Nations Physical Planning Adviser, Mr. Sciskowski, and that it should be chaired by the Commissioner of Land. It was also decided that the Department of Land should take the initiative in choosing the Government-owned land for hotel development.
