Price Listing of Medicinal Preparations.

It was agreed that the Hon. Minister of Trade, Industry and Agriculture should, as from 1st July, 1969, enforce by regulations the reduction in the retail price of the medicinal preparations referred to in Act VIII of 1969 (Imports Duties (Amendment) Act) by an amount equal to the Customs duty from which those preparations had been exempt since the enactment of the Act, i.e. the 24th May, 1969.
