Cabinet Meeting held at the College d'Europe
Valletta, on Thursday, 4th August, 1969, at 11 am.

OPM. 510/69. Visit of Mr. Vladimir Donnac in connection
with T.V. programmes.

Ministers considered
Mr. Donnac's application and also the views
at Pds 5, 6, 10 and 11 in file.

It was agreed that the
necessary visa be issued to Mr. Donnac
for the purpose stated provided that any
filming in Malta should be done in
conjunction with the Department of Information

Any films when processed should be previewed in Malta and, if approved for issue, a copy should be delivered free of charge to the Government of Malta.

Re-activation of the Committee of Users of the Retail Price Index (Memo. No. 1324).

Ministers considered Memorandum No. 1324 and agreed to the recommendations at paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 of the Memorandum.

Grant of certain powers to the Director of Civil Aviation.

Ministers considered the request at Red 16 in file and agreed that the Governor General be advised to authorise the Director of Civil Aviation:

- i) to type-approve aircraft radio apparatus, and
- ii) to approve the installation of radio apparatus in aircraft as well as modifications in radio apparatus and in the manner in which it is installed in aircraft.

Development of Luqa Airport (Memo. No. 1257)

Ministers considered Memorandum No. 1257 and also the note on the discussions with Sig. Murre at Red 490 in file. It was agreed that the British

Government's proposal as at paragraph 16 of the Memorandum be accepted.

It was agreed also that the Italian Government be asked to allow Engineer Marra to be our technical adviser in terms of the Technical Cooperation Agreement, during the discussions.

Ministers considered memorandum Lo. 1364 and agreed that at this stage the importation of prefabricated houses is not desirable.
