the Hon. Minister of Finance, Customs and Port.
The latter would then pass the said papers
to the Prime Minister who would then
advise the former General.

Amendments to the Maltese Citizenship Act 1968 (Memo. No. 1350).

Ministries considered memorandum No. 1350 and agreed that the Act be amended as suggested by the Civil Advocate General in paragraph 3 of the memorandum.

Introduction of Metric Weights and Measures. (Memo. No. 1303).

Ministries considered memorandum No. 1303 and agreed that action be taken as proposed in paragraph 7 of the memo.

Restriction of Pinto and Lami Stores (Memo. No. 1132)

Ministries considered memorandum No. 1132 and agreed that the Minister of Education, Culture and Leisure, the Minister of Public Building and Works and the Minister of Finance, Customs and Ports should consult together about the most practicable way of meeting the situation as explained in the memorandum.

Ministers considered Memorandum No. 1378 and agreed that H.C. the Governor General be advised to make the Commission Agents' (Licensees) (Amendment) Regulations, 1969, referred to in paragraph 5 of the Memorandum.

OPT. 414/68. Director of Statistics (Memo. No. 1379)
Ministers considered Memorandum No. 1379 and agreed to the introduction of a Bill changing the designation of the Principal Government Statistician to that of Director of Statistics.

Third Party Risks Insurance for Motor Vehicles.
Ministers were asked to consider the matter dealt with in minute 704 and agreed that as a matter of policy, foreign-owned companies should not be allowed to expand their business in the field of insurance.

OPT. 957/68. Exemption from the provisions of the Workmen's Law in respect of "Sant Elena" at Birkirkara.
Ministers agreed that a further extension of one year be granted in the case of the Agreement referred to in minutes 11 and 12 and that appropriate

should be asked to do his utmost to comply with the law in the forthcoming year.

OPM. 926/69. Construction of dwellings and stores at Rabat, Malta.

Ministers considered a minute dated 28th August, 1969, addressed to the Minister of Finance, Customs & Port about the construction of fifteen dwellings and five stores at Rabat, Malta, and agreed that the only tender received be accepted.

OPM. 927/69. Construction of Slabs and Sarcophagi at Hamrun

Ministers considered a minute dated 28th August, 1969, addressed to the Minister of Finance, Customs & Port about a revision of the rates in the tender received for these works and agreed that the only tender at the revised rates be accepted.
