2. J.C.P. 47/69 Increase in Customs Warehouse Rent

Ministers agreed that the present ad valorem rent of 1/2% per month be revised as follows:-

1/2% for the first fortnight

2 1/2% for the second fortnight

5% per month thereafter

and that the Customs Regulations, 1957, be amended accordingly.
