o/m 1087/67 Relay Station - Beatoche Walle

Ministers considered Memorandum no 1371B and agreed that except for clause 13 of the Licence, amendments be proposed to Beatoche Walle on the lines of A and B on page 4 of the Memorandum. It was also agreed in principle that the title at D on page 4 of the Memorandum be granted in emphasis to Beatoche Walle.

o/m 161/70 Cargo Shunting by Port Foreman

Dec. 366/62 Section 38 of the Immigration (British Subjects) Ordinance
