Industrial action at the Port

Ministers considered the situation arising out of the industrial action resorted to by the delivery clerks in the employ of the Malta Landing and Shipping Company and agreed to consider the matter further, if the strike continued, in the light of a report which the Superintendent of the Ports was asked to submit indicating the minimum number of workers of each trade and profession that would be required to work at the Port on an emergency basis.
