OLN 1087/67 Deutsche Welle (Lites for the Malta transmitting Station and Studios)

Ministers considered Memorandum No. 1371 a and heard the views of the Commissioner of Land and of the Chief Inspector of Wireless Telegraphy. It was agreed to consider the matter again at a later meeting.

OLN/E/963/62 Appointment of Headmasters/Headmistresses in the new Secondary Schools

Ministers considered Memorandum No. 1561 and agreed to hear the views of the Director of Education at the next meeting before taking a final decision.

OLN 511/71 Extension of retiring age of University conjoint posts.

Ministers considered the request made by the Council of the Royal Malta University that the retiring age of conjoint posts be extended from 60 to 65. It was

pointed out that acceptance of the request would have serious repercussions on all full-time Government employees particularly the consultants in the Medical and Health Department who do not hold conjoint posts in the University.

It was agreed that the Council of the University be informed of these difficulties in writing.
