

MEMORANDUM BY THE HON. MINISTER OF JUSTICE
Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap.136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General covers two plots of land at Ghaxaq.

It is proposed to acquire by title of absolute purchase.

The acquisition involves parts of two premises at St. Mary Street, Ghaxaq.

The site in question is required for widening and aligning the public thoroughfare, and therefore for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Chapter 136.

It emerges from the valuation report of the Land Engineer that the freehold value of the property in question amounts to £276.13s.4d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at Marsascala:

A plot of land of the area of 5 tmien 4 sieghan and 3 kejliet, bounded on the North-North-East, West-North-West and South-South-West by the remaining portion of the land of which such plot forms part; it is the property of the Noble Alexander Apap Bologna.

The above-mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 78/65, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
