

MEMORANDUM BY THE HON. MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of the boathouse underlying premises Nos. 88/97, Siren Street, Senglea.

The land in question is required by the Government in connection with a reconstruction scheme, and it is therefore proposed to acquire it on public tenure terms.

Since the said land is required in connection with a reconstruction scheme, it is required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the recognition rent of the above boathouse amounts to £13 per annum as regards its temporary utile dominium and to £1 per annum as regards its directum dominium.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by way of Public Tenure.

Description of the Land

The boathouse underlying premises No. 88/97, Sien Street, Senglea; it is the property of the Most Noble Baron Jerome De Piro D'Amico as regards the Directum Dominium and of the heirs of Publio Refalo as regards the temporary Utile Dominium.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 237/66, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office - 29, South Street, Valletta.
