

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of part of premises No. 83 and of premises No. 84, St. Rocco Street, Birkirkara.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above land is required by the Government for the development of the Birkirkara Parish Church Area; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above land amounts to £1,285. 0. Od.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Birkirkara:

1. Part of premises No. 83, Saint Rocco Street, consisting of part of a yard, a room, parts of three other rooms, of the area of 12.7 square canes, bounded on the North-East and North-West by property of Doctor Albert Zammit Maempel M.D., on the South-West by property in course of acquisition by Government and on the South-East by the remaining part of premises No. 83, Saint Rocco Street.
2. Part of garden of premises No. 84 Saint Rocco Street, including a well, part of a water tank and three rooms of the area of 117.7 square canes, bounded on the North-West by Saint Helena Parish Church, on the South-West by property in course of acquisition by Government and on the South-East partly by premises No. 83, Saint Rocco Street and partly by the remaining part of premises No. 84 Saint Rocco Street.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 21/71, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
