

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of three (3) plots of land at Marsaxlokk.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plots of land are required by the Government for the widening of San Luciano Road; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the total freehold value of the above plots of land amounts to £M284,451.8.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned Land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Marsaxlokk:

1. A plot of land of the area of 1 Siegh, 5.8 Kejliet (296.01 square metres), bounded on the North-East by property of the Air Ministry and on the South-East by a public road.
2. A plot of land of the area of 5 Sieghan, 5.9 Kejliet (1047.3 square metres), including a well, together bounded on the North-West by property of the Most Noble Lino Testaferrata Bonici, on the South-West by property of the Air Ministry, and on the South-East by a public road.
3. A plot of land of the area of 5 Sieghan, 0.1 Kejliet, (938.64 square metres), bounded on the West and North-West by a public road and on the South-East by property of the Most Noble Lino Testaferrata Bonici.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 148/72, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
