

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of six shops and a mezzanin at Old Theatre Street/Old Bakery Street, Valletta.

It is proposed to acquire these premises under possession and Use terms.

The above premises are required by the Government in connection with reconstruction purposes; they are therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the acquisition rent of the above premises amounts to £M145.00,0 per annum.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be for the possession and use thereof for such time as the exigencies of the public purpose require.

1. Shop No. 112, Old Theatre Street.
2. Shop No. 113, Old Theatre Street.
3. Shop No. 114, Old Theatre Street.
- Shop No. 116, 117, 118, Old Theatre Street corner with 68, Old Bakery Street.
4. Shop No. 68A, Old Bakery Street.
5. Shop No. 70, Old Bakery Street.
6. Mezzanin No. 71, Old Bakery Street.

The above-mentioned premises are shown on plan marked L.D. 179/72, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
