

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a farmhouse along Gheriexem Street, Rabat.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above farmhouse is required by the Government in connection with the construction of St. Paul's Avenue; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the above farmhouse amounts to £1,450, 0.0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the undermentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land

The following land at Kabit, Malta:-

Farmhouse without number situated along Gheriexem Street, bounded on the North by Gheriexem Street, on the West by St. Paul's Street, and on the East and South by property of Mr. Joseph Bonello and others.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 259/69, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
